NOTIFICATION TO THE PARTIES

CONCERNING:

Ministerial Conference of the Central African  
States for the Wildlife Conservation

1. The abovementioned Ministerial Conference is an official organization whose purpose is to establish co-operation and consultation at the regional level with respect to wildlife conservation and anti-poaching efforts between the following countries: Cameroon, Congo, Gabon, Central African Republic and the Sudan.
2. For this purpose, two agreements have been signed:
  - Agreement of co-operation and consultation between the central African States on wildlife conservation;
  - Agreement between the central African States for the creation of a special fund for wildlife conservation.
3. Regarding the special fund, the agreement allows for the possibility of the fund also being sustained through the proceeds of the sale of specimens seized in member States, and in other States where appropriate. For this reason, the Permanent Secretariat of the Ministerial Conference would like to be informed of any seizure or confiscation of specimens originating from one of the member States, as well as any attempted violation of the Convention involving them.
